Dear Mr. Benavides:

On or about January 4, 2002, Councilmember Mitchell Rasansky resigned his appointed position as City Council Trustee for the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System ([Exhibit "A"](#)).

Pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act (Texas Open Records Act), Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, please identify the following information regarding the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System, its employees, and its Board of Trustees (collectively, the "Pension System"):

1. The number of City Council Trustees appointed to the Pension System's Board of Trustees as-of December 4, 2001, the month immediately before Councilmember Rasansky's resignation of January 4, 2002;
2. The number of City Council Trustees appointed to the Pension System's Board of Trustees as-of February 4, 2002, the month immediately after Councilmember Rasansky's resignation of January 4, 2002;
3. The date and location of any and all meetings held by the Pension System's Board of Trustees to publicly deliberate Councilmember Rasansky's resignation of January 4, 2002; and,
4. The name and date of appointment for Councilmember Rasansky's successor to the Pension System's Board of Trustees. If none, please provide the reason for reducing the number of appointed City Council Trustees on the Pension System's Board, as well as the date and location of any and all meetings held by the Pension System's Board of Trustees to publicly deliberate reducing the number of appointed City Council Trustees following Councilmember Rasansky's resignation of January 4, 2002.

Please note that we are requesting that your office compile information responsive to this Open Records Request. Should documents responsive to this request not be available,

please note that there is also considerable knowledge within the Pension System to include both its Administrator and Chairman who, according to the Pension System's website, have served the Pension System continuously for over twenty years.

Please advise should you have comments or require additional information. We appreciate your anticipated cooperation, and look forward to hearing from you at the earliest possible time. Thank you.
