Dear Mr. Benavides:

On March 9, 2000, Dallas City Councilmember Donald Hill was “*at his request*” appointed to the Investment Advisory Committee for the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System ([Exhibit “A”](#)). On April 14, 2000, the Dallas Police and Fire Pension System acquired seven commercial properties in and around the downtown Dallas Victory Project area, to include the four-story office building now used by the Pension System for its offices and Board room ([Exhibit “B”](#)).

On July 30, 2000, Sgt. Rector McCollum was appointed to the Board of Trustees for the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System. Sgt. McCollum who, according to his biography, administered confidential records for the Dallas Plan (a long-range urban planning project), was appointed by the Board of Trustees to fill the unexpired term of Captain Dwight Walker ([Exhibit “C”](#)).

Pursuant to the Texas Public information Act, Chapter 552, of the Texas Government Code, please provide the name and date-of-application for any and all other candidates considered by the Dallas Police and Fire Pension System’s Board of Trustees in filling Captain Dwight Walker’s unexpired term. Please note that we are requesting that your office compile information responsive to this Open Records Request, and that a written itemized statement of estimated charges be provided in advance of work being started should the estimated charge exceed \$10.

Please advise should you have comments or require additional information. Thank you.
